In Factory

Prior to the loading onto the road transport whenever possible we will do a complete external visual inspection of the hulls, rudder, skeg, and below water fixtures. Antifouling is best done before leaving the factory

Offloading from Truck

We will oversee offloading from the truck either onto the hard or to water and the transfer to a safe berth.

- Check for cathode protection prior to launch.
- Check for correct fitting of underwater appendages.
- ☐ Check for any damage during road transport

Dock Trials

Dock Trials will be composed of Equipment Tests and Propulsion Tests while the vessel is still tied to the dock

Equipment Tests:

Prior to sea trials, all equipment and machinery will be thoroughly tested for a length of time sufficient to demonstrate satisfactory workmanship and operational suitability for the purpose intended.

Engine Tests:

The main propulsion engine and the Genset will be inspected.

Sea Trials

After a satisfactory dock trial, the vessel is to proceed on sea trials. The vessel will be crewed and under the command of an appointed yacht captain.

Defects and Exceptions:

Any defects, discrepancies and exceptions found during the commissioning and sea trials will be itemised and rectified as soon as practicable after their discovery.
